PETER YARROW CONCERT SCHEDULED FOR JUNE 30

Hiawatha Music Cooperative and the City of Marquette announce a concert by folk music legend, Peter Yarrow, scheduled for Friday June 30. The event will begin at 7 p.m. in the Kaufman Auditorium in Marquette. This concert is made possible by a generous donation from John and Pauline Kiltinen.

Peter Yarrow's talents as a creative artist, both with legendary trio Peter, Paul & Mary and as a solo performer, are frequently directed at using music to convey a message of humanity and caring. His gift for songwriting has produced some of the most moving songs from Peter Paul and Mary, including "Puff the Magic Dragon," "Day is Done" and "Light One Candle". As a member of the renowned musical trio, Yarrow has earned multiple gold and platinum albums, as well as numerous Grammy Awards. Over the years, many issues – including equal rights, peace, the environment, gender equality, homelessness, hospice care, and education – have moved Peter to commit his time and talent.
